Variety Type: Full Season, medium viscosity Peel / Dice

Adaptability Regions: California, South America

Disease Resistance: VFFNP

Vine Type: Large, prostrate

Fruit description: 84 grams, elongated-square

Processing: 5.6 °Brix

Compare to: Seminis - HP 303



Special Notes: Very high NTSS. Uniform fruit shape and size. Fruit hold better than an average variety, but not EFS. Excellent foliage cover, with very little sunburn on the fruit.

Variety Type: Second Early, Paste, Crush, Peel, Dice

Adaptability Regions: Canada, Europe, Asia, South America

Disease Resistance: VFFN TY Ps Bw

Vine Type: Medium vine with acceptable cover

Fruit description: 64 grams; blocky-oval shape

Processing: 5.0 °Brix

Compare to: H9478

Special Notes: Some tolerance to bacterial spot under light disease pressure. Excellent setting ability.
